



Disputing non-compliances




1   If you feel that the non-compliance (or observation) is not a fair reflection of what was found at your site on the day (e.g. wrong or inaccurate), you can dispute the finding.

2 You need to enter your reasons for the dispute as well as attached evidence supporting your case (for example photographs or scanned documents).

Click 'submit'

Please note the limit to file size!

Please note – you will NOT be able to view/change your dispute once submitted, so please check it is complete.

3 The status of the NC will change to  This will send an alert to the audit firm and ask them to review the dispute. If the audit firm accepts the dispute they will make the relevant changes &  status will show. If the audit firm rejects the dispute you will see . You will receive email alerts when the status changes.

Observation New Business Critical

Audit clause: 1 - Freely chosen employment

Issue title: 1 - The audit was not completed in full due to an intentionally obstructive practice (e.g. the auditor was denied access to relevant documents or areas of the site, permission to interview workers etc.)

Root cause: Training, System, Costs, Lack of workers

Corrective action: Ut suscipit erat sem, et congue eros pharetra rutrum. Pellentesque rhoncus magna vel turpis rhoncus consequat. Sed semper mauris nec justo sagittis, nec pellentesque nulla tempor. Nunc pretium lacus est, dictum scelerisque nisi posuere sit amet. Donec id dictum magna, id porta libero. Vivamus rutrum lobortis est, vitae fringilla magna tincidunt sit amet. Vivamus suscipit lectus velit, ut tincidunt ligula porta vitae. Pellentesque habitant morbi tristique senectus et netus et malesuada fames ac turpis egestas. Cras rutrum justo nec consequat dignissim. Morbi commodo maximus bibendum. Pellentesque habitant morbi tristique senectus et netus et malesuada fames ac turpis egestas.
